Nixon Road Drainage & Street Improvements will improve the daily commute for the citizens of Nixon Rd. as well as minimize flooding and ponding conditions during storm events.

Proposed Flood Mitigation Improvements:

Features and benefits of Nixon Road Drainage & Street Improvements include and are not limited to the following:

- Improved road conditions for homeowners living along Nixon Road. Street repair will begin at the intersection of FM 508 and continue all the way to the city limits where the road will match the recently paved section by Cameron County.
- Improved drainage system by re-grading roadside ditches and conveying storm water towards CCDD#5’s system and detention facility.
- Improved accessibility and a welcoming street environment
- Decreased property damage after storm events
- Contributes to increased neighborhood livability, appearance, and property values.
